



ABC News report "A woman has been arrested for allegedly putting something in her child's intravenous line at Cincinnati Children's hospital, records show. Candida "Candy" Fluty, 35, of Kermit, West Virginia, was arrested on charges of child endangerment and felonious assault over the weekend, according to inmate records.

She "knowingly injected a substance into the victim's peripheral IV line" in a hospital room, the arrest report reads. The municipal county court complaint states that the victim was under 18 years old and Fluty was the child's mother. It says the complaint is based on Fluty's statements and video evidence from Jan. 16. It was unclear from the court documents what the substance was.
