Abstract:

THE FDA approved the use of I.V. acetaminophen in November 2010, but it has been commercially available in many countries outside the US since 2001.¹ I.V. acetaminophen is indicated for managing mild-to-moderate pain, moderate-to-severe pain along with adjunctive opioid analgesics, and fever in adults and children as young as 2 years.² This article examines the evidence supporting the use of acetaminophen and reviews important nursing considerations.
